Fulton County Sheriff's Office Introduces "Check the Stats" Feature on FCSO App Providing Public Access to Essential County Jail Data

Atlanta, GA – The Fulton County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) is committed to fostering a transparent and accountable relationship with the residents and stakeholders of Fulton County. To further this commitment, we are excited to introduce the "Check the Stats" feature on the FCSO External App. This feature provides the public with access to essential data about the County Jail, including jail population, personnel (including staff levels), facility maintenance, outsourcing of inmates to other facilities, and comprehensive healthcare information (inmate wellness, hospital visits, pharmacy services and illness).

By providing the public with easy access to key data, we aim to foster trust and maintain an open dialogue with the community we serve.

Key Highlights of the "Check the Stats" Feature

- 1. Jail Population: Stay informed about the current jail population and observe trends over time. This data allows citizens to understand the impact of various factors on the correctional system.
- 2. Outsourcing and Loan Out Data: Understand FCSO's approach to managing resources efficiently, including information on outsourcing initiatives to better manage the jail population and loaning personnel to other agencies as needed.
- 3. Facility Maintenance: We believe that well-maintained facilities are crucial for efficient operations. Through this feature, the public can access data related to facility maintenance and understand the efforts undertaken to provide a safe and secure environment.

- 4. Healthcare: We recognize the importance of providing comprehensive healthcare services to inmates. The "Check the Stats" feature offers detailed data on various healthcare aspects, including:
- Inmate Wellness: Information on programs and initiatives focused on the physical and mental well-being of inmates.
- ER Send Outs: Data on instances when inmates require medical care beyond the facilities' capabilities and are sent to external medical facilities for treatment.
- Pharmacy: Insights into medication management and dispensation to ensure proper healthcare for inmates.
- Sick Call: Data on the frequency and nature of medical visits initiated by inmates for non-emergency medical concerns.
