Fulton County Inmate Death at Rice Street Jail

Atlanta, GA – Fulton County inmate Montay Stinson, age 40, was found unresponsive in his cell on Monday, July 31, 2023, at approximately 11:45 p.m. Jail and medical personnel responded in attempts to revive Stinson but were unsuccessful. Stinson was found with no obvious signs of injury.

Stinson was arrested by the Atlanta Public Schools Police Department and booked into the Rice Street Jail on October 5, 2022. He was being held on a 2nd degree burglary charge with a \$3,000 bond. The Fulton County Medical Examiner's Office will perform an autopsy to determine the cause and manner of death.
