Inmate Found Unresponsive in Cell Dies Days Later at Grady Hospital

Atlanta, GA – Shawndre Delmore, age 24, was discovered unresponsive during a routine check by a detention officer at 8:19 p.m. on Thursday, August 31, 2023. Jail staff performed lifesaving measures in attempts to revive Delmore until advanced medical staff arrived. Delmore was taken to Grady Memorial Hospital where he remained unresponsive. Delmore died on Sunday, September 3, 2023.

On April 1, 2023, Delmore was arrested by the Atlanta Police Department for Burglary in the Second Degree and Willful Obstruction of Law Enforcement Officers and booked at the Fulton County Jail. He was being held on \$2,500 bond on the burglary charge and signature bond on the obstruction charge.

The Atlanta Police Department will conduct a death investigation and Fulton County Medical Examiner's Office will conduct an autopsy.
