Inmate Found Unresponsive in Fulton County Jail Pronounced Deceased

Atlanta, GA – Inmate Travis Landrey was found unresponsive in his cell this morning at the Rice Street Jail. Lifesaving measures were performed by jail and medical staff but were unsuccessful and Landrey was pronounced deceased.

The Atlanta Police Department is conducting an investigation and the Fulton County Medical Examiner's Office will perform an autopsy. The preliminary cause of death is suicide.
