Fulton County Jail Resident Found Unresponsive, Later Dies at Hospital

Atlanta, GA – Fulton County Jail resident Judas Wilson was discovered unresponsive in his cell on the morning of January 30, 2025, at the Rice Street Jail. Medical and jail teams administered lifesaving measures before he was transported by EMS to a local hospital. Despite these efforts, he was pronounced dead on February 3, 2025.

Wilson had been in custody without bond since August 31, 2020, facing multiple felony charges. The Fulton County Sheriff's Office expresses its deepest sympathies to his loved ones during this difficult time.

The Fulton County Medical Examiner's Office will conduct an autopsy to determine the exact cause of death, though preliminary findings suggest suicide.
