Death of Fulton County Jail Resident

Atlanta, GA – Cef Green, a 25-year-old resident of the Fulton County Jail, was found unresponsive in his cell on March 3, 2025, at the Rice Street Jail. Despite immediate emergency medical efforts by the jail team as well as the medica team, Green was transported to a local hospital where he was later pronounced dead.

Green was arrested by the Atlanta Police Department and had been in custody since April 29, 2024, held on a \$50,000 bond for aggravated sodomy. The Fulton County Sheriff's Office expresses its deepest sympathies to his loved ones during this difficult time.

The Atlanta Police Department will conduct a death investigation and the Fulton County Medical Examiner's Office will conduct an autopsy to determine the exact cause of death, though preliminary findings suggest suicide.
