Death of Fulton County Jail Resident

Atlanta, GA – Fulton County Jail resident Benjamin Pike, age 55, was found unresponsive in his cell during headcount on the evening of Tuesday, May 27, 2025. Jail and medical teams attempted to perform lifesaving measures on Pike, however, were unsuccessful. He was pronounced dead at the Fulton County Jail.

On February 22, 2024, Pike was arrested by the Georgia State University Police Department and was being held at the Fulton County Jail on a \$2,500 bond.

The Atlanta Police Department is conducting a death investigation, and the Fulton County Medical Examiner's Office will conduct an autopsy on Pike to determine the exact cause of death. The Fulton County Sheriff's Office extends its condolences to his family.
